

# China MBBS Study Visa Checklist for Pakistani Students 2026

China has become one of the most popular destinations for Pakistani students pursuing MBBS due to affordable tuition fees, internationally recognized universities, and English-medium medical programs. Before applying, students should prepare all required documents carefully to avoid delays in admission and visa processing.

## Basic Personal Documents

- Valid Passport (minimum 18 months validity)
- 4-8 Passport-size photographs with white background
- Completed University Application Form
- Study Plan (300-500 words)
- Updated CV/Resume
- Self-Introduction Video (required by some universities)

## Medical Documents

- Foreigner Physical Examination Form
- Blood Test Reports
- ECG Report
- Chest X-Ray
- HIV Test Report
- Hepatitis B Test
- Doctor's Signature and Hospital Stamp

## Character and Legal Documents

- Police Character Certificate
- Birth Certificate (required by some universities)
- Family Registration Certificate (FRC)
- Non-Criminal Record Certificate

## Financial Documents

- Bank Statement (USD 5,000–10,000 equivalent)
- Bank Maintenance Certificate
- Sponsor's CNIC Copy
- Salary Slip or Income Proof
- Affidavit of Financial Support
- Tax Return (optional)

## Attestation Requirements

Pakistani students are strongly advised to complete:

- IBCC Attestation
- MOFA Pakistan Attestation
- Notarized English Translation (if required)
- Chinese Embassy Legalization or Apostille (if requested by university)

## Documents Issued After Admission

Once admission is confirmed, the university will provide:

- Admission Letter
- JW201 Form (Scholarship Students)
- JW202 Form (Self-Financed Students)
- Tuition Fee Receipt (if advance payment is required)

## China Student Visa Documents

For X1 Student Visa, students need:

- Original Passport
- Visa Application Form
- Recent Photographs
- Admission Letter
- JW201/JW202 Form
- Medical Examination Report
- Bank Statement
- Police Character Certificate
- Flight Reservation (if required)
- Accommodation Information
- Previous Chinese Visa Copies (if any)

## Additional Documents Required by Some Universities

- Two or three blank visa pages in passport
- Self-introduction video
- Motivation letter
- Recommendation letters
- HSK Certificate (for Chinese-medium programs)
- IELTS or TOEFL (only for selected universities)
- Online interview
- Financial Guarantee Letter

## Eligibility Criteria for Pakistani Students

- ✓ Age between 17-25 years
- ✓ FSc Pre-Medical with Physics, Chemistry and Biology
- ✓ Minimum 60% marks (higher marks improve scholarship chances)
- ✓ Good physical and mental health
- ✓ Valid passport
- ✓ No criminal record

## Important Advice

Before applying for MBBS in China, Pakistani students should ensure that the university is recognized by the Chinese Ministry of Education and fulfills PMDC requirements. Students planning to practice medicine in Pakistan should verify PMDC recognition and National Licensing Examination (NLE) requirements before taking admission.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### Is IELTS required for MBBS in China?

Most Chinese universities do not require IELTS. An English Proficiency Certificate from your college is usually sufficient.

### Is MBBS in China recognized in Pakistan?

Yes, provided the university is recognized and graduates meet PMDC regulations and pass the National Licensing Examination (NLE).

### What is the duration of MBBS in China?

The MBBS program normally lasts six years, including internship.

### Which visa is required?

Students studying MBBS in China require an X1 Student Visa.

### How much bank statement is required?

Generally, a bank statement showing USD 5,000-10,000 equivalent funds is recommended, although requirements vary by university.
